Core responsibilities include:

- Facilitate a safe environment for all children in the program through close supervision, and direct communication with staff.
- Foster positive interactions with students through activities, games, help with homework, and simply helping them navigate their afternoon.

This is an excellent opportunity to work with a diverse group of young adults, many of which are on the path to a degree in education. This supportive environment, has been a springboard for many individuals in the program, including coaching, tutoring, substitute teaching, and lead teaching positions. Preferred qualifications include: prior experience working with children, excellent communication skills with children and adults, and the attributes of a patient, creative, dynamic, and enthusiastic individual.

The McGillis School is a progressive, independent school with enrollment open to all. The school serves 435 students in grades K-8. Teachers in the lower school grades have an assistant teacher in each classroom.

Our child-centered approach enables students to acquire knowledge and positive experiences in learning through developmentally appropriate curriculum. Students at the McGillis School play an active part in constructing and producing knowledge as they pose and solve problems. We emphasize the integration of subject matter, hands-on learning experiences, and cooperative learning within classrooms.
